"People have come from up to 3 hours away," she says, noting that in the animal world, this kind of loving attention and the obvious relief it brings are hard to keep secret. "I've even had a rabbit, a goat and a kitten in the water!"

After 10 successful and busy years, True Balance Animal Wellness's Canine Aquatic Gym will be closing in mid October, but dogs (and their humans) can rejoice: Beane is transitioning to a home care model, bringing the mountain to her patients right where they are.

Beane has had a blast swimming with dogs and looks forward to expanding the reach of the other services she offers, which have changed so many lives—canine and human—for the better.

"I'll be refocusing my practice on vet referred home visits for pre-op prep, post-op rehab and senior wellness throughout the tri-state area and beyond," she says. "If you have a pet with an injury or surgery, I can be there to prepare your home for their safety and comfort, plus develop pre-op and post-op exercise plans."

The full suite of services includes class 3B cold laser, individualized exercise plans, injury prevention, bodywork instruction, and geriatric support enhancing quality of life. As a supplemental tool, laser treatments can reduce inflammation, decrease pain, speed wound healing and promote healthy cell growth amongst other things."
